Some useful information for studying abroad

Visa

For studying in Germany, you will need a residence permit (visa). To apply for a visa, you need to make an appointment at your German embassy in your country. Please check online with the appropriate German embassy beforehand.

Health insurance

In Germany it is compulsory to have health insurance, below you will find a selection of insurances from which you can choose. It is important that you take out a student health insurance. The cost will be about 100 Euro per month. You must apply for a membership to the chosen health insurance company. Unfortunately, the website is in German, please use a translator e.g., Google.

Bank account

As a foreign student who is not from an EU Member State, you must furnish proof that you have the financial means to pay for your course of studies and for supporting yourself during your studies. Proof of financial resources must usually be provided when you apply for an entry visa and is a precondition when you apply for a residence permit in Germany. In this case a **blocked bank account** is needed. This type of bank account implies that your money will be "blocked" for the duration of your stay in Germany. The amount that needs to be transferred serves as a guarantee that you can uphold an appropriate standard of living abroad and is defined by German authorities. Even though the funds fully belong to you and are held in your name, you do not have access to the whole amount at once and receive a monthly allowance into your regular bank account opened at a German bank of your choice.

In 2020, the amount of € 861.00 must be blocked for every month that you are planning to stay in Germany as a student – this would be €10,332.00 for one year. However, we strongly recommend that you check the required sum at the website of the local embassy or respective authority.

Please make sure to enter your country of origin in the search box to ensure that eligible scholarships are displayed.

Pay attention to the requirements you must meet for a selected scholarship. You can usually find the requirements on the respective homepage or in the application form.

Language requirements

In some non-EU countries, it is obligatory to prove that you have taken an **A1 German language course** in order to apply for a visa. In addition, the language course is a prerequisite for admission to the master's program.

This course can usually be made up on site. The German Adult Education Center (Deutsche Volkshochschule) will offer an A1 language course in the winter semester, which you can most likely attend. More detailed information will follow soon.

Note:

If you cannot find an apartment directly in Quakenbrück, there is the possibility to look for an apartment in the surrounding area, next to the railroad line Osnabrück - Wilhelmshafen (Nord-West-Bahn). Possible cities would be for example: Osnabrück, Bramsche, Bersenbrück, Essen (Olb), Cloppenburg, Ahlhorn, Oldenburg. With the student ticket, which you receive when you enroll, you can use this train for free.

There is also a possibility to establish contact with a private person who would like to rent out their apartment. The cost of renting the apartment is 250 euros per month. The apartment has three rooms and both a kitchen including kitchenette and a bathroom.
